Ce livre retrace la vie mouvementée de Nichiren, moine bouddhiste japonais du XIIIe siècle. Né à une époque-charnière d’un Japon traversé par des crises politiques et religieuses, Nichiren s’est révélé le plus grand réformateur bouddhiste de son époque. Cherchant à assurer le bonheur du peuple accablé par les calamités (pestes, famines, inondations, invasions…) et déchiré par les dissensions politiques et l’incapacité des religieux, son enseignement révolutionnaire non seulement réaffirme, dans la droite ligne du Bouddha historique Shakyamuni, l’atteinte de la boddhéité par tous, mais en fournit les moyens. À PROPOS DE L’AUTEUR
Masaharu Anesaki (1873-1949) est un universitaire japonais, pionnier dans différents champs de l’histoire des religions. Après avoir été diplômé de l’Université Impériale de Tokyo (maintenant Université de Tokyo), Masaharu Anesaki alla en Inde et en Europe continuer ses études (1900-1903). De retour au Japon, il fut nommé au département des sciences des religions de l’Université Impériale de Tokyo. Anesaki commença sa carrière académique par des études sur les religions indiennes, particulièrement le bouddhisme. Il fut l’un des premiers à appliquer l’objectif moderne, la méthode historique

à l'étude du bouddhisme. Il commença aussi une recherche sur l'histoire de Kirishitan, la forme spécifiquement japonaise de catholicisme roman durant la période de son bannissement, du XVIIe jusqu'à la moitié du XIXe siècle. Il s'intéressa de plus en plus à Nichiren, moine du XIIIe siècle, et publia en 1916 Nichiren, le moine bouddhiste visionnaire.
